CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (2021-22) SIKKIM GOVERNMENT COLLEGE, NAMCHI

In the academic year 2021-22, the institution walked up a milestone by successfully conducting numbers of events. Month-wise event details are as follows:

June

On 21st June 2021, the 4 Sikkim NCC Battalions cadets of Sikkim Government College, Namchi under the supervision of Dr. Bikash Sharma performed "Yoga Asana". More than 100 students participated in this event, maintaining COVID-19 guidelines the event was performed at their own respective places.

July

Nature Club and NSS volunteers of SGC, Namchi under the supervision of Dr. Kamal Poudyal, took plantation drive under the theme, "A Day for Mother Earth"- a day for the protection and conservation of our mother nature- at their respective places due to COVID-19 guidelines.

August

Resource person of the webinar was Dr. Sudipto Ghosh, overall in-charge of North-East Region for conducting FACT programme (NCFE). He discussed about various financial issues like identify theft protection, responsible use of credit card, education loan borrowing principles, how to avoid impulse buying, going cashless, and how to set financial goals. He also covered the other areas relating to finance such as insurance, mutual funds, pension funds and other investment plans. He also highlighted the various schemes of Government of India related to financial inclusion such as Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jyoti Bima Yojana, Sukanya Samridhi Yojana etc.

October

On 29th October 2021, the 4 Sikkim NCC Battalions cadets of Sikkim Government College, Namchi under the supervision of Dr. Bikash Sharma, organised cleanliness drive under the theme, "Clean India Campaign" at the surroundings of the college premise.

November

On 26th November 2021, the Department of Political Science, SGC, Namchi under the headship of Dr. Panu Ongri Pazo, organised talk on Constitution Day on the theme, "Important Aspects of the Indian Constitution and its Relevance in the Present Indian Scenario". The keynote speaker and Chief Guest of the programme was Advocate Kumar Nepal, who spoke on different aspects of the constitutional law and its implications in the society. He also covered topics on Fundamental Rights and Directive Principles of State Policy, different writs and its usages, the types of offences based on mistake of fact and mistake of law. He also spoke on the articles dealing with the amendment of

the constitution and the role of legal bodies in workplaces. He discussed the hierarchy of the judicial system and different tribunals and their jurisdiction.

December

On 8th December 2021, the Department of Political Science and Sociology, SGC, Namchi under the headship of Dr. Panu Ongri Pazo, organised One-Day Seminar on the theme, "Negotiating Between 'History' and 'Nation' in Eastern Himalayas Moving Towards a Himalayan History' at the college auditorium. Dr. Vinayak Sundas, Assistant Professor, Centre for Himalayan Studies, North Bengal University (NBU) was the speaker of the session. The speaker delineated the issues of nationhood and the multidimensional ethnic cultures and how they play an important role in bringing identity politics to the forefront of political demands in the region. He also spoke about the Pan Himalayan culture as a unique formation of transboundary movement and migration of people within the region.

On 15th December 2021, one day trekking cum retreat program was organised by NCC Cadets of SGC, Namchi under the supervision of Dr. Bikash Sharma. The trekking route was from Namchi Bazar to Perbing Dara, and 60 NCC cadets took part in the trek.


